## Cooks' Information Sheet

**There are some exciting changes to the event this year. We are moving to The Event Center located at the Erie County Fairgrounds.**

If you are a past competitor, you know about the hospitality extended to the teams by the Patchin Fire Company. This year, there is a way for you to give something back. We've researched the "sampling" issue, and have worked with the County Health Department so that we can offer samples to the public. Because we are KCBS and NEBS Sanctioned and Inspected, the Health Department will allow the Patchin Fire Company to purchase a permit to cover the competitors offering samples. Here's how this will work:

Sample tickets will be sold to the public for \$2.00. \$1.00 will go to the Patchin Fire Company, \$1.00 will go to you. You trade a small sample for a ticket, and at the end of the day you will be paid \$1.00 cash for each ticket you turn back in. Sampling will be from 2:00 pm until 5:00 pm, and you will need to maintain Health Department Food Safety standards. Participation is not mandatory, but is appreciated. Please make sure to mark whether or not you will participate when returning your entry form.

The 2012 KCBS rules apply to the contest. This contest is sanctioned by the Kansas City Barbeque Society (KCBS). A rulebook may be obtained from the KCBS web site [www.kcbs.us](http://www.kcbs.us) Click on Downloads and then click on "Rules and Regulations."

Individual categories will be awarded trophies for first place through 10<sup>th</sup> place. Prize money will be awarded based on the number of entries received. KCBS Rules will apply. To qualify for the Grand Championship, Contestants must cook all the categories and turn in the entries on time, in a standard 9 x 9 styrofoam box (issued).

## ***Boston Hills BBQ Fest NEBS Wide Open Grilling Contest Continued***

**ALL PREPARATIONS MUST TAKE PLACE ONSITE FOLLOWING MEAT INSPECTIONS BY A CONTEST OR KCBS REPRESENTATIVE.** Meat may **not** be in marinade or seasoned in any way prior to the Official Meat Inspection. Meat Inspection will begin on Saturday following the KCBS Award Ceremony on Saturday. Teams may set up on Saturday night, but must be checked in and inspected **BEFORE** the Judges Meeting on 11:00 am on Sunday June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

Any type of **GRILL OR SMOKER** - fueled by charcoal or propane may be used, and any type of ingredient or garnish may be used, as long as the entry is identifiable and there are a minimum of 6 portions.

**NEW THIS YEAR: NO DEEP FRYING OF ENTRIES ALLOWED – ALL ENTRIES MUST BE GRILLED USING CHARCOAL OR PROPANE FUEL, OR ASSEMBLED ON-SITE.** For example, in the chicken category, the chicken must be grilled or smoked. It cannot be breaded, and deep fried. If a team wanted to garnish with deep fried broccoli, that would be fine – as long as the chicken itself is grilled using either charcoal or propane, or both.

Entries will be judged, and graded on appearance, taste, and tenderness. Any questions will be answered at the Cook's Meeting.

### **Trophies and Prize Money**

Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> Overall (Grand Champion), 2<sup>nd</sup> Overall (Reserve Grand Champion) each day. Individual categories will be awarded trophies for 1<sup>st</sup> Place – 10<sup>th</sup> Place for KCBS, and 1<sup>st</sup> Place – 5<sup>th</sup> Place for NEBS Wide Open Grilling. Payout is based on the number of teams entered. 2011 payout will be based on the number of participants, and paid the day of the contest. The field will be limiting to 50 teams. With a full field each day, we will have approximately \$11,000 in prize money to award.

### **Cook Site Information:**

Sites will be approximately 20' wide x 25' deep, and will be assigned on a first come first serve basis.

Sites will be assigned based on your specific needs, no additional space charges will apply.

Teams wishing to purchase a dedicated, full RV hookup site, may do so for a cost of \$25/night

Water will be available, you provide your own hoses and (Y) connectors.

Electric will be available, you provide your own extension cords.

Ice will be available, delivered to your site.

Trash will be removed by event staff, please bring your own receptacles and bags.

Indoor Restroom facilities will be available at all times.

**SHOWERS** (Yes, SHOWERS!) will be available

Ash and grease disposal will be available onsite.

Please no open fires or fire rings on the ground.

Portable, off ground firepits are welcome.

Sanitation (Wash, rinse, disinfect) will be checked at meat inspection, and on the day of the contest.

Proper storage of meat is required. It must be maintained below 40F or above 140F.

Proper handling of food is required. Vinyl or latex gloves should be used.

The Event Center is located on the Erie County Fairgrounds near the Hamburg Casino.

**From Downtown Buffalo**

Travel south over the Skyway on Route 5 to Milestrip Road (Route 179) east to McKinley Parkway and head south about 4 miles.

**Traveling East on I-90 (NYS Thruway)**

(Coming from Pennsylvania) Take exit 57 to Route 75 north. Turn right on to Southwestern Blvd (Route 20). Make a right onto McKinley Parkway. The Fairgrounds on on the right.

**Traveling West on I-90 (NYS Thruway)**

(Coming from Amherst, Rochester, Syracuse) Take the I-90 West to exit 56 (Blasdell/Milestrip). Turn left onto Milestrip Road (Route 179). Turn right on the McKinley Parkway. The Fairgrounds is on the left about less than 4 miles.

**From Route 219**

Take Route 219 to Armor Duells exit. Go west on Armor. Bear left onto Clark Street. Go past signal at Clark and McKinley, to Clark Street. Enter the Fair at Clark Street entrance.

**From the Buffalo Niagara International Airport**

Take the 33 Expressway and follow the signs to the NYS Thruway (I-90) to Route 219 and travel this to Boston State Road exit, turn right and turn right onto McKinley Parkway. Take this to Clark Street and turn left, The Fairgrounds will have a lot on the right hand side.

**From Canada, via the Peace Bridge**

Start out going east on Peace Bridge. Turn slight right. Merge onto NYS Thruway (I-190S) toward Downtown Buffalo, merge onto NY-5 W via Exit 7 toward Lackawanna. Take the exit toward NY 179, enter next roundabout and take 3rd exit onto NY 179E (Milestrip Road). Turn right on McKinley Parkway and The Fairgrounds will be about 4 miles down on the right hand side.

**From Canada, via the Queenston-Lewiston Bridge**

Start out going northeast on Robert Moses Parkway N toward Robert Moses Parkway S. Take Rt-104W/RT-18F ramp. Turn slight right onto NY 104/NY-18F/Center Street/Ridge Road/CR-907. Continue to follow Ny-104/NY-18F/Center Street/CR-907. Turn left to take Rt-104W ramp toward I-190W/Canada/Buffalo. Turn slight right onto NY-104/Lewiston Road. Turn left onto Military Road/NY-265, turn right onto Upper Mountain Road/Cr-11. Merge onto I-290S toward Niagara Falls/Buffalo, merge onto NY-5 W via Exit 7 toward Lackawanna. Take the exit toward NY 179, enter next roundabout and take 3rd exit onto NY 179E (Milestrip Road). Turn right onto McKinley Parkway, The Fairgrounds will be about 4 miles down on the right hand side.
